Camorace Max Quick Start Guide

From correct mounting to your first complete recording.

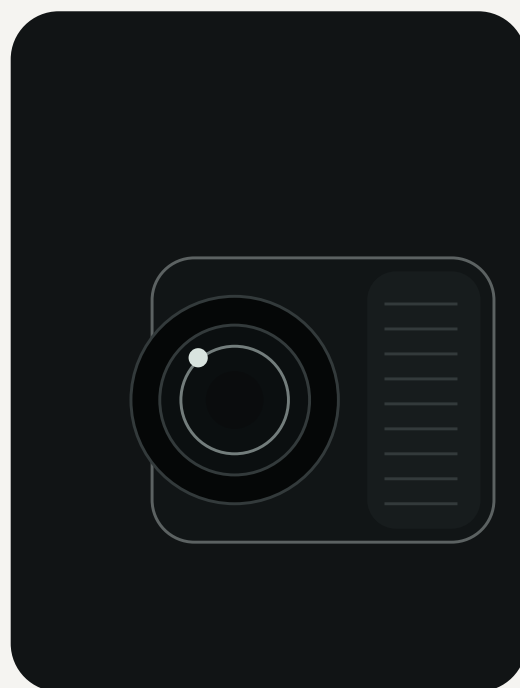


01 / PREPARE

Before you begin

A few quick checks help make the first recording reliable.

- Charge the camera and battery. Keep charging contacts and protective covers dry and clean.
- Install a supported memory card, then format it in Camorace App before first use.
- Clean the removable lens protector so fingerprints, dust and water spots do not enter the image.

**TIP**

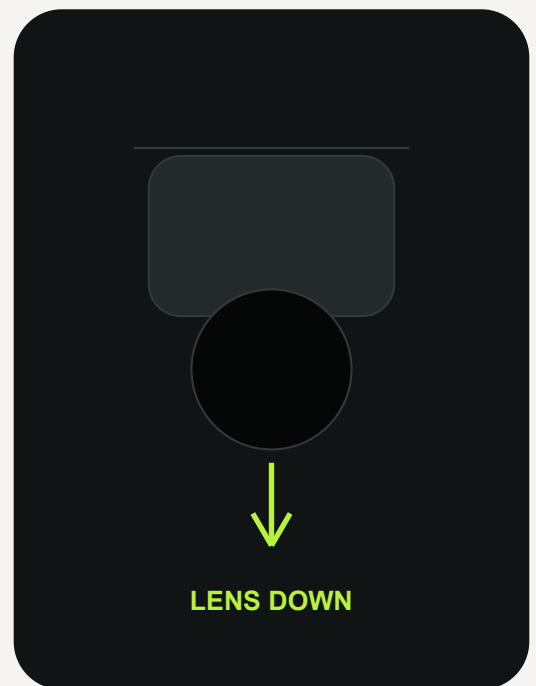
Record a short test clip and review it in the App before a full session.

02 / MOUNT

Install with the lens down

Inside the vehicle, keep the body above and the panoramic dome facing down.

- Choose a rigid, flat location that does not block the driver's view.
- Clean the mounting surface, press the base firmly and lock every adapter point.
- Check that the lens is unobstructed and no cable enters the driver's control area.



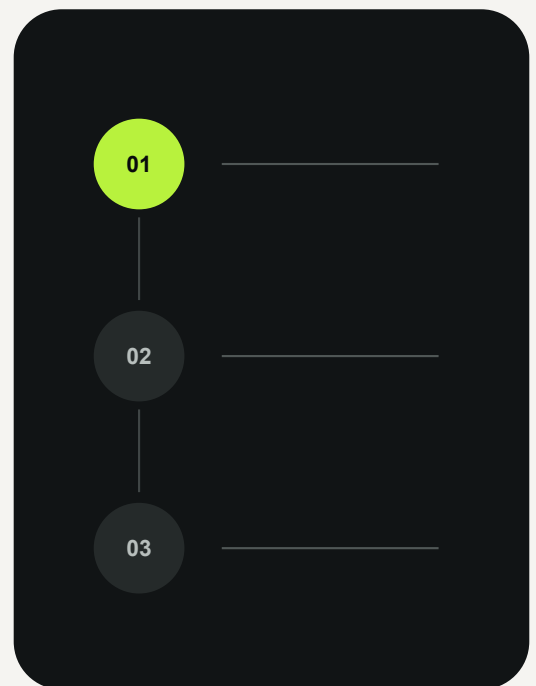
TIP Inspect the base, adapters and lens protector before every session.

03 / CONNECT

Connect Camorace App

Follow the in-app guidance for first connection and essential settings.

- Power on Camorace Max, open Camorace App and choose Add Device.
- Allow the required system permissions, then select the nearby camera.
- Confirm time, storage, recording mode and alert preferences.



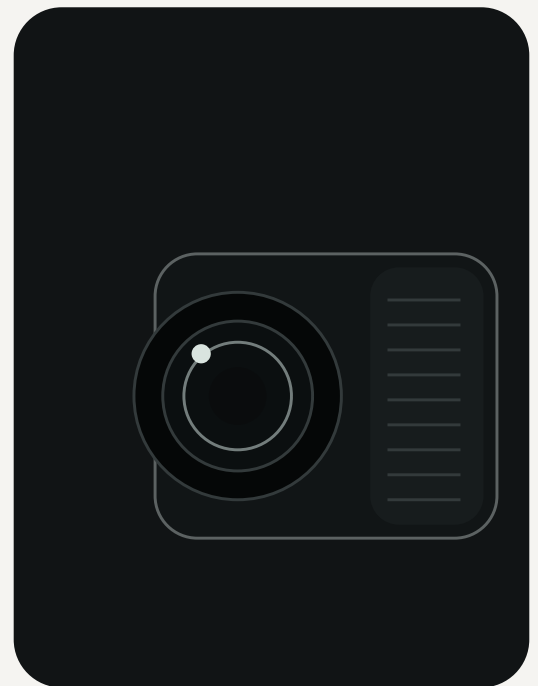
TIP If the camera is not found, keep it nearby and reopen the connection page.

04 / RECORD

Complete the first recording

Confirm the camera, storage and data state before moving.

- Wait until the camera is ready, then check battery level and available storage.
- Start recording and observe the status indication. Recheck only while safely stopped.
- After the drive, stop recording before powering off or removing storage.

**TIP**

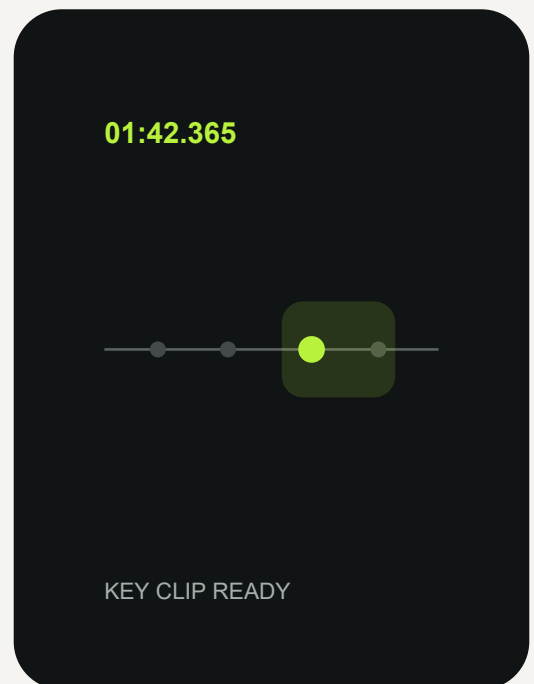
Follow circuit, event and local safety rules. Operate the device only while safely stopped.

05 / REVIEW

Find the critical second

Camorace places video and driving data on the same timeline.

- Lap timing: tap the fastest lap or any lap to jump to the matching segment.
- Rally and off-road: tap top speed or maximum G to return to that moment.
- A suggested clip range is prepared automatically; adjust its boundaries and viewing direction before export.



TIP Record everything first. Choose the view and output after the key metric is found.
