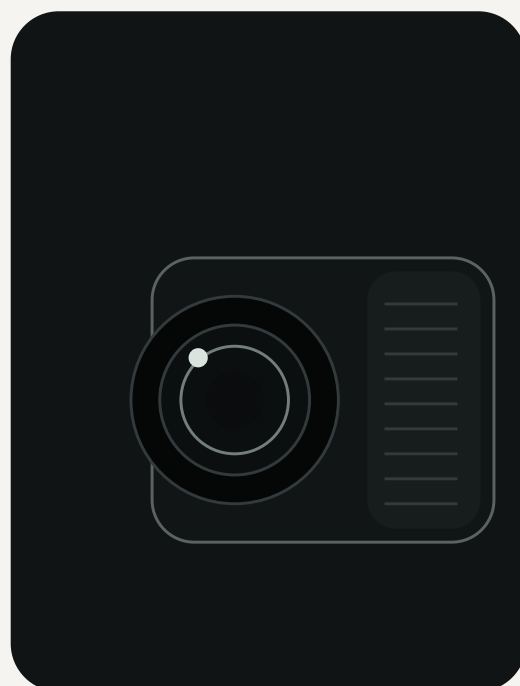


01 / PRODUCT

Meet Camorace Max

A panoramic imaging and driving-data system for circuit, rally and off-road use.

- The camera records panoramic video and the driving session.
- The removable lens protector provides daily protection and must be kept clean.
- Battery, charging case, memory card and mounting accessories complete the system.



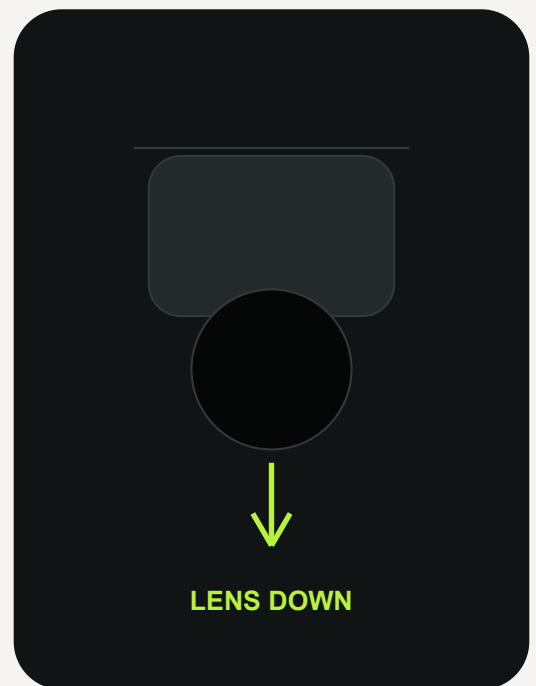
TIP Included items may vary by sales package.

02 / SAFETY

Mounting and operating safety

Stable installation and correct orientation are essential for reliable recording.

- Inside the vehicle, keep the lens down and the body above without blocking the view or safety equipment.
- The mounting point must withstand driving vibration; inspect it again before a session.
- Do not adjust the camera, cable or mounting parts while the vehicle is moving.



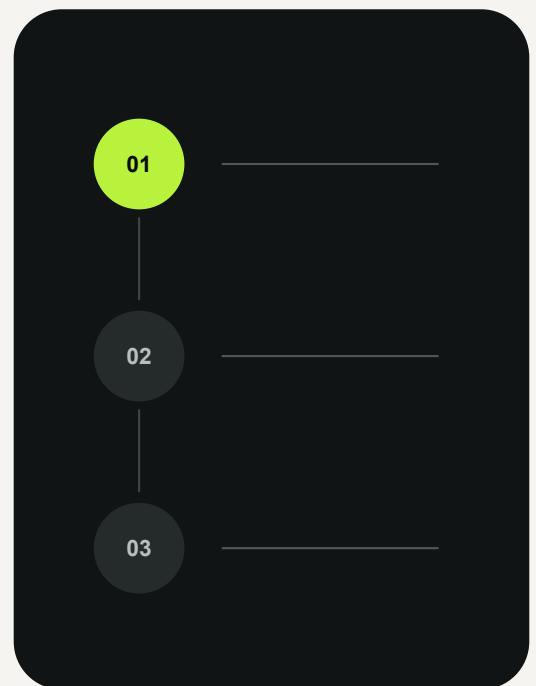
TIP Inspect the housing, protector and mount after heat, impact or severe vibration.

03 / POWER

Battery and charging

Correct charging, storage and temperature control help protect battery life.

- Use compatible batteries, the charging case and suitable power equipment.
- Keep contacts dry. Stop using a battery that leaks, smells unusual or is visibly deformed.
- For long storage, keep the battery in a cool, dry location and inspect it periodically.



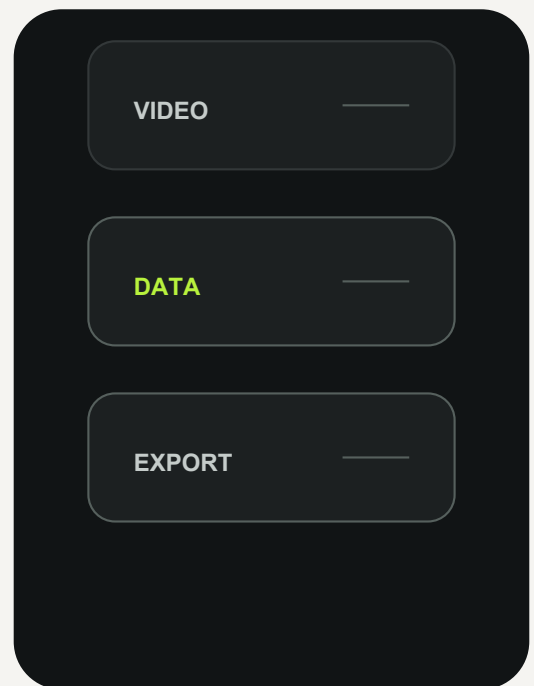
TIP Do not disassemble, crush or puncture the battery, and keep it away from flame and extreme heat.

04 / STORAGE

Memory cards and files

High-bitrate panoramic footage needs stable, sustained storage performance.

- Format the memory card in the App before first use or after changing devices.
- Check free space before recording and copy important sessions to another location promptly.
- Stop recording and allow file writing to finish before powering off or removing the card.

**TIP**

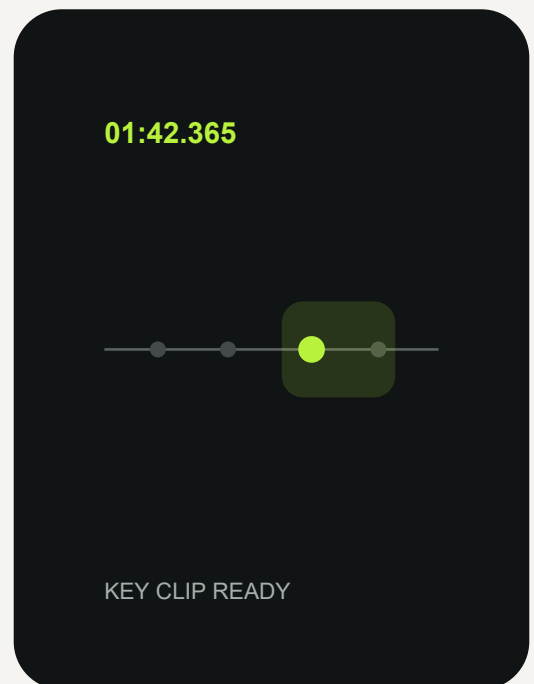
Formatting erases the card. Back up anything you need to keep first.

05 / RECORD

Video and driving data

Camorace aligns panoramic video, laps, speed, G-force and route on one timeline.

- Keep the lens clear and wait until the camera is ready to record.
- Lap sessions focus on the fastest and any selected lap; rally and off-road focus on top speed and maximum G.
- After driving, verify footage integrity and data alignment in the App or desktop software.

**TIP**

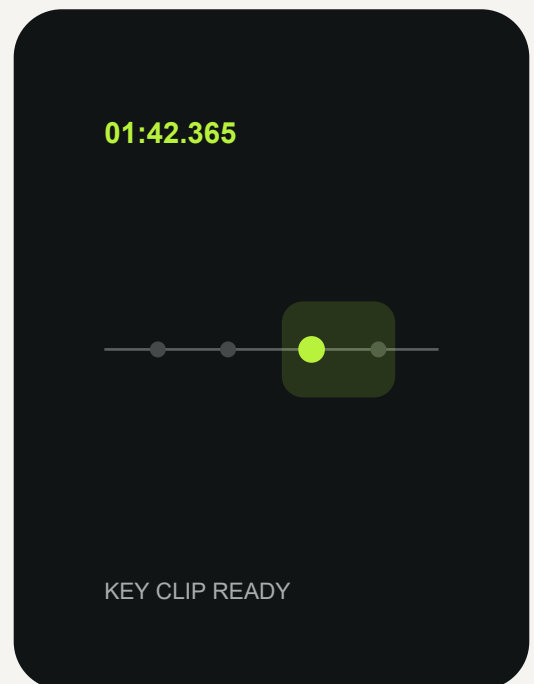
Driving data supports review and content creation; it does not replace official timing, safety or vehicle diagnostic systems.

06 / APP

Connect, reframe and export

Camorace App manages the camera, footage, metric jumps and mobile output.

- Open a session and drag the viewing direction to reframe the panoramic image.
- Tap a key metric to move the video playhead and suggested clip range together.
- Before export, verify viewing direction, clip boundaries, audio and overlay choices.

**TIP**

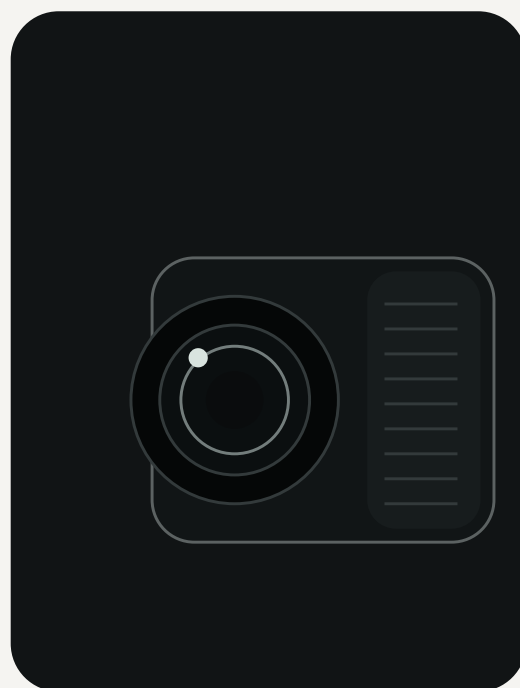
Process large sessions with sufficient battery and a stable connection.

07 / CARE

Cleaning and maintenance

The lens protector and camera body require different care.

- Use a soft lens cloth on the protector and avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Disconnect power before cleaning and keep liquid away from openings and battery areas.
- Use protective storage during transport so the protector does not contact hard objects.

**TIP**

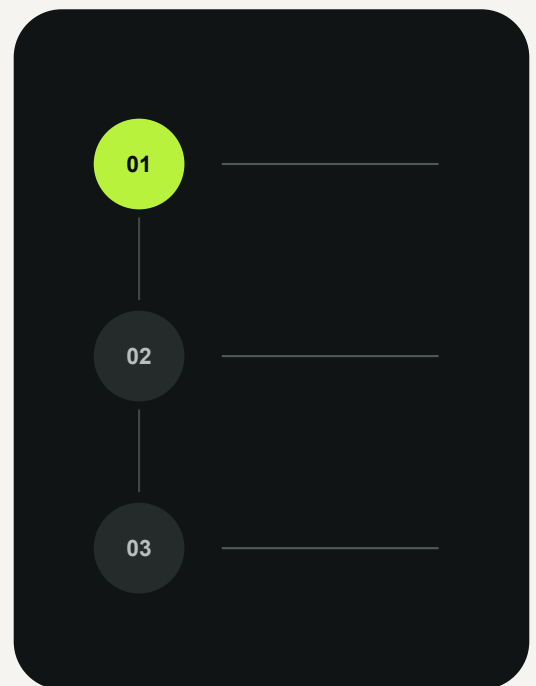
Replace a protector that is visibly scratched, cracked or loose before recording again.

08 / SUPPORT

Troubleshooting and service

Check power, storage, connection and software version first.

- No power: check battery seating, charge level and contact points.
- No recording: check the memory card, free space and formatting state.
- No connection: keep the camera close, restart camera and App, and confirm permissions.

**TIP**

If the issue remains, record device state, software version and reproduction steps before contacting Camorace support.
